Producing At PADNET 2

Course Description

This seminar is an introduction to the basics of producing videos in both the field and in the studio. Topics include show development for content creation, filming techniques, and planning your production from start to finish.

Course Objectives / Certification

Attendance and completion of Producing at PADNET certifies a PADNET Member to submit Project Proposals. Project Proposals are the necessary first step for reserving equipment, edit suites, and the studio.

Class Policies

Students must register for classes at least 48 hours in advanced. Walk-ins are not accepted. All classes require a minimum of 3 students. If a class has less than 3 students, the class will be cancelled and a PADNET staff member will contact you to reschedule or issue a refund.

If a registered student can no longer attend a class, the student can receive a full refund if PADNET is notified with more than 48 hours in advanced of the class time. If the student cancels with less than 48 hours of the class time, students will receive 50% of their payment back or a half credit toward another class.

If a registered student does not show up for class, the student will not receive a refund or credit.

- Post-production:
 - What to expect and think about in editing
 - Working with an editor
 - Submitting your show for broadcast
