

FIELD PRODUCTION: LIGHTING

Course Description

Learn how to set up lights in the field. This class offers hands-on training with the Lowel Light Kit, gels, umbrellas, reflectors, on-camera lights and proper set-up and breakdown of equipment. You'll also learn the procedures and policies for checking out PADNET equipment.

Course Objectives / Certification

Attendance and completion of Field Production: Lighting certifies a PADNET Member to gain access of the Lowel Light Kit, LED on-camera light, and reflector available at The Hub and PADNET Satellites. Project Proposals are required for all equipment reservations.

Materials Needed

- Pen and paper to take notes with
- Grip gloves (optional)
- A Mac-formatted hard drive to copy video files from class (optional)

Class Policies

Students must register for classes at least 48 hours in advanced. Walk-ins are not accepted. All classes require a minimum of 3 students. If a class has less than 3 students, the class will be cancelled and a PADNET staff member will contact you to reschedule or issue a refund.

If a registered student can no longer attend a class, the student can receive a full refund if PADNET is notified with more than 48 hours in advance of the class time. If the student cancels with less than 48 hours of the class time, students will receive 50% of their payment back or a half credit toward another class.

If a registered student does not show up for class, the student will not receive a refund or credit.
